

Initial Cohort of Mem-ExSpan Students

How the Program Affected Their Futures Twenty to Twenty-Five Years Later

This is a set of thirty clients Jan Erland taught personally in small groups of 3-5 when founding the program. What happened to them? The outcome is shown 20-25 yrs. later. Pre- and post training cognitive skills tests were administered using The Woodcock-Johnson Pscho-Educational Cognitive Skills Battery, The Test of Cognitive Skills (TCS), The Learning Efficiency Test, and The Detroit Tests of Learning Aptitude. Many of these students entered at low levels with cognitive deficiencies, and these weaknesses were improved and transferred to higher academic achievement and work proficiency.
